3. 词数少于 80 或多于 120 的, 从总分中减去 2 分。
4. 评分时, 应注意的主要内容为: 内容要点、应用词汇和语法结构的数量和准确性以及上下文的连贯性。
5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面, 评分时, 应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
6. 如书写较差以致影响交际, 可将分数, 降低一个档次。

1. 恰当的开头;
2. 比赛的时间、地点;
3. 比赛的基本情况 (参赛人员、演讲内容、结果);
4. 你的看法。

### (三) 各档次的给分范围和要求

第五档 (21~25 分): 完全完成了试题规定的任务, 完全达到了预期的写作目的。

- 覆盖所有内容要点。
- 应用了较多的语法结构和词汇。
- 语法结构或词汇方面有些许错误, 但为尽力使用较复杂结构或较高级词汇所致; 具备较强的语言运用能力。
- 有效地使用了语句间的连接成分, 使全文结构紧凑。

第四档 (16~20 分): 完成了试题规定的任务, 达到了预期的写作目的。

- 虽漏掉一两个次重点, 但覆盖所有主要内容。
- 应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。
- 语法结构或词汇方面应用基本准确, 些许错误主要是因尝试较复杂语法结构或词汇所致。
- 应用简单的语句间的连接成分, 使全文结构紧凑。

第三档 (11~15 分): 基本完成了试题规定的任务, 基本达到了预期的写作目的。

- 虽漏掉一些内容, 但覆盖所有主要内容。
- 应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。
- 有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误, 但不影响理解。
- 应用简单的语句间的连接成分, 使全文内容连贯。

第二档 (6~10 分): 未适当完成试题规定的任务, 信息未能清楚地传达给读者。

- 漏掉或未描述清楚一些主要内容, 写了一些无关内容。
- 语法结构单调、词汇项目有限。
- 有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误, 影响了对写作内容的理解。
- 较少使用语句间的连接成分, 内容缺少连贯性。

第一档 (1~5 分): 未完成试题规定的任务, 信息未能传达给读者。

- 明显遗漏主要内容, 写了一些无关内容, 原因可能是未理解试题要求。
- 语法结构单调、词汇项目有限。
- 较多语法结构或词汇方面的错误, 影响对写作内容的理解。
- 缺乏语句间的连接成分, 内容不连贯。

不得分 (0 分): 未能传达给读者任何信息: 内容太少, 无法评判; 写的内容均与所要求内容无关或所写内容无法看清。
